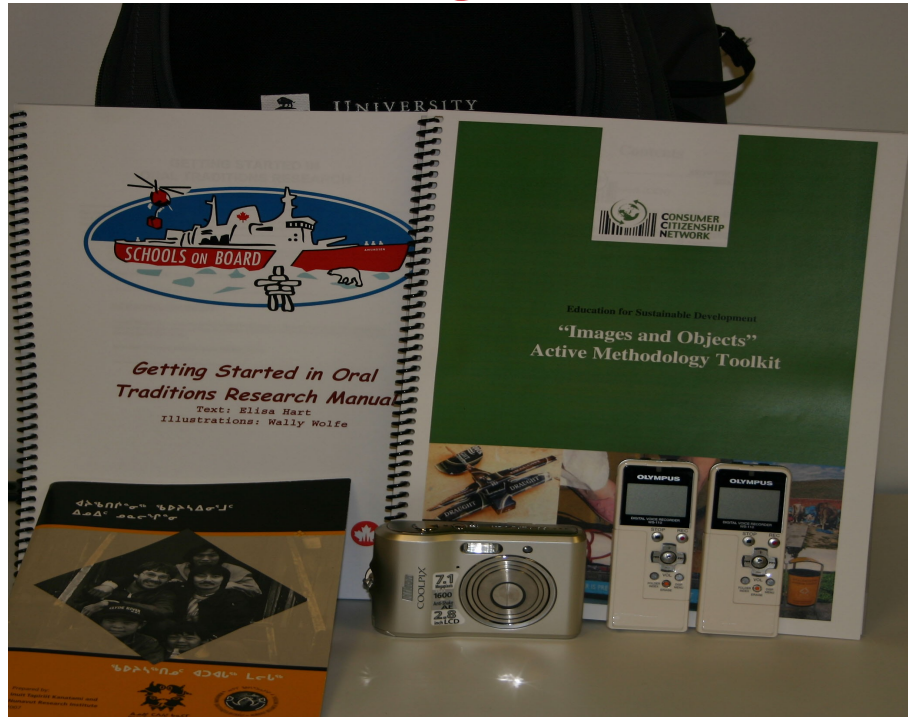




Traditional Knowledge Collection Kits and Images Activity



The Schools on Board Traditional Knowledge Collection kit includes a set of 10 backpacks which each have;

- Digital camera
- Digital voice recorder
- Getting started in Oral Traditions Research Manual
- Negotiating Research Relationships with Inuit Communities Manual
- Consent forms
- Sample interview questions

These kits include everything students need to begin interviewing their elders regarding the environment, environmental change, climate change, stories and legends, and traditional knowledge.

Images Activity:

From a collection of images based on climate change and sustainable development, participants select a photograph that has personal relevance. Participants will split into pairs to discuss their image of choice. The discussion will be aided with predetermined questions. After their discussion the pairs will present their opinions and observations to the class. This activity will allow the students to gain a better understanding of the various perceptions, concerns, and priorities. They will leave with knowledge of what the key points and issues of climate change were that came up during the discussion.
